Identified Need:

Due to the new pandemic of SARS-CoV-2 and its primary clinical disease, Corona-virus disease 2019 (COVID-19) there is a need for all clinicians to be able to identify people with the virus infection and COVID-19 disease. Skin signs of systemic disease has led to the identification of other pandemic viral diseases. Recently cutaneous findings of COVID-19 have been described.

Expected Outcome:

Enhanced healthcare provider knowledge and skills that modify participant's behavior to improve the quality of patient care.
